Youth Club Rules

Chieveley Cricket Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well being of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect, are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with Bradley Merchant - Youth Cricket Manager.

As a youth member of Chieveley Cricket Club you are expected to abide by the following youth club rules:

- ✓ All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions
- ✓ All members must respect opponents
- ✓ Youth members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late
- ✓ Youth members should inform their coach or team manager as soon as possible if unavailable for match through illness or similar reason
- ✓ Youth members must wear suitable kit (helmet, box and gloves for batting and wicket keeping when playing with a hard ball) for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager
- ✓ Youth members must pay any fees for training or events promptly
- ✓ Youth members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions
- ✓ Youth members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club
